The basilica of Sacré Coeur

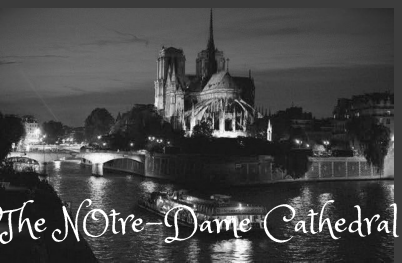

This Arc de Triomphe, the largest in the world was built in 1806 to celebrate Napoleon's victory at Austerlitz.



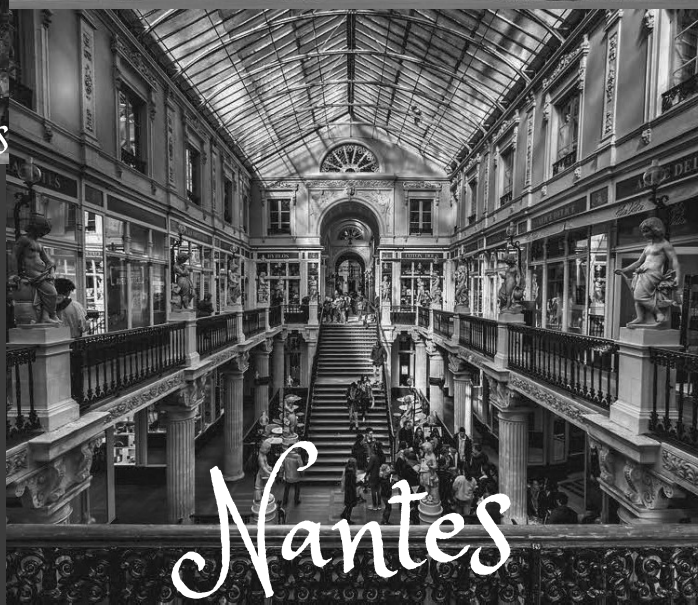

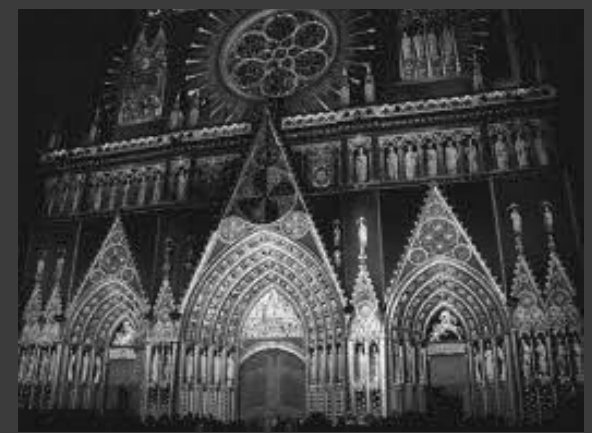
